The Project Timothy 3 (using Zoom) went off amazingly well. We had people signing up to join right up until the last day. Altogether there were 20 participants. PT3 concentrates on teams and team work. Praise the Lord for Susan Chapman who understands the PT3 really well and was able to help me with my part of facilitating as the course has changed radically from when I last did it.

Praise the Lord for the Participants too, they engaged with the material really well, and expressed grateful thanks for the time of learning. Pray that the Lord will continue to use them and what they learned as they seek to build up their teams and in understanding one another.

I was also involved as producer for the New Daniel Personnel Training. A repeat of the July course, also working with Susan Chapman.

Praise the Lord for his help and encouragement during these courses.

The Student numbers at LLC are significantly decreased because of Covid. New Language Learners have been unable to come into the country and others who have been at LLC for a year or more have moved out to begin the next stage of Daniel Training which means being involved in church plants etc. according to their designation.

Some of the Learners who have been unable to come to Thailand due to Covid, have been able to begin on-line language study which is obviously not ideal as they don't have Thais all around them with which to practice new vocab and language skills also made complicated by the different time zones people are in.

I was involved in a few on-line Skype checks whilst at LLC, but also Physical ones! (when the Student, Thai language teacher and me were actually in the same room!) A couple of folk came for Exams too. One guy was doing his Level 3 exam which marks the end of formal language learning for him. He works in the North East and did really well in the exam.

Covid has affected many of them who have been unable to find language helpers during this time, or who have been able to have on-line lessons, either with our own language teachers at LLC or from elsewhere—this is not an ideal situation but it is the best solution for many. If students slacken off in their language learning, sometimes it is very hard to get going again.

I was able to go to Singburi church to speak in one of the Sunday morning services there. There was a good number of people, which means social distancing is not that easy, but most people continue to wear masks which is also important.

Sadly the government decided that they should have a long public holiday during this time, so the traffic will be horrendous as people head out of Bangkok to get away, so probably staying home is the best thing to do, as Bangkok will be empty!

Pray that I will be able to have a rest and relaxing time whatever I do.

Achera and I are hoping that we will be able to spend some time together even if it means just going to a coffee shop.

Pastor Suphochot, who is head of ACT (the OMF association of churches in Central Thailand) has just said that he is really concerned that some churches are beginning to go off at a tangent, due to the fact that during lockdown many people were using youtube and the internet for teaching and spiritual encouragement and sadly have not been discerning in what they have watched or listened to. The ever present “prosperity gospel” stance being just one of the issues.

Will Brooks, Chris Keiller and I are hoping to have a few more Lay leadership training sessions during November.

Please pray for us that as God opens up opportunity for training and spending time with leaders and church members, that some of these issues will be addressed.
