I was also asked to teach at the Thai get together weekend in Manchester. This co-incided with the opening of the new OMF office in Manchester, so I was able to attend that too.

I have finally managed to do some invigilating although fitting it around my schedule has not been easy. Some interesting conversations have occurred during these times. One of the other invigilators, who is a Muslim, and I have developed a friendship and we have had some interesting conversations. Also in my flats there are several Muslims whom I have managed to chat to, although they seem very wary of me. One lady though has begun to greet me when we meet outside of our complex. I pray that I may be able to develop a friendship with her that is more than just a greeting.

Pray for me that I will have wisdom in the words to say, not only to these women but everyone I meet.

My friends, Elizabeth, Marjorie, and I had a holiday together in Hungary. It was a lovely time, concentrated on Budapest. Going into the synagogue was really sobering and challenging, knowing what The Jews have suffered.
